Instructions to Candidates

Candidates must have the following scanned documents ready before proceeding for online application for Admission to B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Courses of study offered by the College:

1. Recent passport size colour photograph (**Size between 40 Kb to 50 Kb**)
2. Signature of the candidate (**Size between 40 Kb to 50 Kb**)
3. Age proof certificate viz. Admit Card of Secondary Examination / Birth Certificate (**Size between 140 Kb to 150 Kb**)
4. Marksheet of Higher Secondary Examination or its equivalent. (**Size between 140 Kb to 150 Kb**)
5. Caste Certificate issued by Govt. for SC/ST/OBC if applicable (**Size between 140 Kb to 150 kb**)
6. BPL Ration Card (if applicable) (**Size between 140 Kb to 150 Kb**)
7. EWS Certificate currently issued (if applicable) (**Size between 140 Kb to 150 Kb**).
8. PWD Certificate issued by Govt Health Centre (if applicable) (**Size between 140 Kb to 150 Kb**).
9. Migration Certificate if candidate belongs from other than WB Board/CBSE/ICSE/NIOS. (**Size between 140 Kb to 150 Kb**)

No candidate shall be allowed to take admission after a lapse of more than 3 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

Eligibility Criteria for SEMESTER WISE FOUR-YEAR B.A./ B.Sc. (Honours with or without Research):

A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

Or

55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

Or

50% marks in the aggregate when the student has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.

Students belonging to Reserved Categories taking up Honours Course of Study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% marks in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be.

A student shall be allowed to take up the subject(s) under heading "A" if he/she had passed the subject(s) under heading "B" at the previous qualifying examination

Eligibility Criteria for Semester wise THREE-YEAR B.A./B.Sc. (Multidisciplinary)

- A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examination is eligible to seek admission to the 1st semester of the B.A./B.Sc. (Multidisciplinary) Course of Studies provided the student has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100.
- Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational examination conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.A. (Multidisciplinary)

A student shall be allowed to take up the subject(s) under heading “A” if he/she had passed the subject(s) under heading “B” at the previous qualifying examination

Eligibility Criteria for the Semester wise Four-Year B.Com.Honours or Honours with Research

A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

Or

55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

Students belonging to Reserved Categories taking up Honours Course of Study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% marks in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be.

Related subjects: Accountancy, Business Economics including Business Mathematics, Business Organization, Mathematics, Business Mathematics, Economics, Statistics, Business Studies, Office & Secretarial practice, Financial Accounting, Elements of Cost Accountancy and Auditing, Book keeping, Commerce, Cost Accountancy and Principles of Management, Commercial Law and Preliminaries of Auditing, Costing & Taxation.

Eligibility Criteria for Semester-wise Three-Year B.Com.

- A candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examination is eligible to seek admission to the Three-Year B.Com Degree Course of Studies provided he/she has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100 & Related Subjects.

Related subjects: Accountancy, Business Economics including Business Mathematics, Business Organization, Mathematics, Business Mathematics, Economics, Statistics, Business Studies, Office & Secretarial practice, Financial Accounting, Elements of Cost Accountancy and Auditing, Book keeping, Commerce, Cost Accountancy and Principles of Management, Commercial Law and Preliminaries of Auditing, Costing & Taxation.
